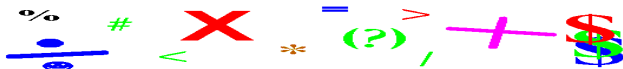

Eddie J. White K-8 6th grade Goals

Eddie J. White K-8 Academy administrators and teachers have reviewed the student performance data to determine our areas of improvement. To increase math proficiency by 5% measured by the 2019 Georgia Milestone Assessment.

The Middle school Team

The 6th grade team will work with students and their families to increase students' success in mathematics.

Teacher will:

- Establish My Math passwords and send home
- Log sheet to note at least 15 minutes practicing Math skills , on Sum dog and / or IXL
- Send home review packets covering weekly skills
- Offer Math Tutorials after school or weekly sessions
- Offer academic curriculum nights concentrating on math activities and skills

At Home

EWA 6th grade parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support students' success in mathematics.

- Allow for students to visit Math websites and log time, MyMath, Sum dog, and IXL at home or the library.
- Allow students to attend after school tutorial
- Use math in home activities
- Check out and visit the Parent Resource Center for math resources
